## Frequently Asked Questions about our *A-Team*:

**What exactly does a member of the *A-Team* do?** *A-team* members assist with administrative projects (such as data entry or organizing) that could be done at home. *A-team* members also assist with organizing events, event set-up projects, and follow-up projects.

**How often is an *A-Team member* needed?** Projects arise on an as needed basis. *A-Team* members are typically asked to serve 3 or 4 times a year.

**Are any additional time commitments involved?** *A-Team* members are asked to attend any "All-Arts" events. Also, optional social and community service events may be planned throughout the year and are communicated well in advance as we hope families will join us!

## Frequently Asked Questions about our *E-Search Research Team*:

**What exactly does an *E-search Researcher* do?** An *E-search Researcher* researches information for our speakers, including current articles, statistics, stories, quotes, and other relevant factoids.

**How often is an *E-Search Researcher* needed?** Needs for various forms of information vary depending on the message topic and series. At various times, an email request will be sent to the whole team or to an individual asking for research regarding a specific topic.

**Are any additional time commitments involved?** *E-search Researchers* are asked to attend any "All-Arts" events. Also, optional social and community service events may be planned throughout the year and are communicated well in advance as we hope families will join us!

## Frequently Asked Questions about our *Handy Helpers Team*:

**What exactly does a *Handy Helper* do?** *Handy Helpers* do just that... help! They grab a paint brush, grab a hammer and nails, or grab a pair of scissors. *Handy Helpers* are eager to do "whatever" is needed to complete the simple details of a project.

**Will I have to design anything?** No. Our *Stage Designers* and/or *Hammerheads* construction team will design the project. They will provide clear instructions for the *Handy Helpers* team.

**Do *Handy Helpers* use their personal equipment?** With the permission of our facilities manager, Jim Lindbergh, Forest Hill's equipment can be used. There may be instances where personal equipment is needed.

**When and where are projects created/built?** If an individual is working on a project and it is more convenient, the project may be completed at home and then brought to the church. Work on larger projects can happen at the church during weekdays, at night or on weekends. Any "work day" or "work evening" should be requested through our creative arts director, Allison Tubbs, to make sure there is no conflict in using the building during the scheduled time.



# HELPING TEAMS

**Will someone provide direction for projects?** *Handy Helpers* work very closely with the *Stage Designers* and *Hammerheads* teams who will provide specific instructions. A separate meeting may be set to discuss the project plans. Additionally, a "work day" may be scheduled in which the *Stage Designer*, *Hammerhead* team, and *Handy Helper* team are present. It is also typical, once instructions are given, for *Handy Helpers* to work "on their own" at the church or at home, depending on the project.

**How often are team members expected to be a part of a project?** Projects needs are determined by how often the stage design changes as well as how many props are requested by speakers. Typically, a team member would help with 4 -6 projects a year.

**Are any additional time commitments involved?** *Handy Helpers* are asked to attend any "All-Arts" events. Also, optional social and community service events may be planned throughout the year and are communicated well in advance as we hope families will join us!

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
